Cross Country Duo Among Four Student-Athletes Honored by the CACC

Senior **Melissa Rennekamp** (below right) and freshman **Faith Anderson** were honored as Runners of the Week by the Central Atlantic Collegiate Conference (CACC) in an announcement made by the conference on Monday, September 18th. Rennekamp was tabbed the Runner of the Week while Anderson was named the league's Rookie of the Week for first-year Head Coach **Dave Thomas**.



A native of East Stroudsburg, Pa., Rennekamp finished 30th out of 262 runners at the New York

University Cross Country Invitational this past weekend, turning in a time of 21:15. Anderson, meanwhile, placed 41st overall at the NYU Invitational with a time of 21:29, helping the Lady Rams to a 12th-place finish in the team standings.

In addition to the cross country duo, junior women's tennis standout **Maddie Smith** and freshman women's soccer player **Kim Garen** were also recognized by the CACC for their respective performances last week. Smith posted a perfect 4-0 record, combined singles and doubles, in helping the Lady Rams to a 2-0 mark and stretching the team's season-opening win-streak to five matches. Garen, meanwhile, scored a pair of goals in the Lady Rams' lone contest of the week, an 8-0
